**Minneapolis, MN** – To build momentum for the upcoming fundraising efforts in honor of a double lung transplant patient, a website has been created to spread the word about Kali Grace McKellips' miraculous first year of life. The site will provide an easy, accessible way for friends, family and interested parties to volunteer their time and money.

Born extremely premature at 24 weeks, on June 11, 2006, Kali weighed a mere 1 ½ pounds. Since birth, Kali has remained hospitalized and heavily medicated at Minneapolis Children's hospital, on ventilation and oxygen, but her undeveloped lungs continued to cause health problems. Recently, Kali was transferred to Texas Children's Hospital and put on a donor list for a set of new lungs. A donor was found within several weeks and on Tuesday, April 17, 2007, 9 month-old Kali Grace underwent a risky, yet successful, double lung transplant. With many more days of healing ahead, Kali and her parents remain in Texas, hundreds of miles away from home.
