## Silent Auction Rules

### Silent Auction Rules:

- The silent auction will start at 4:00pm and close upon announcement by the Master of Ceremony, approx. 7:00pm. At that time we will systematically work through the items to accept payments and release the goods.
- Bidding increments must be equal to or exceed the minimum increase figure stated on the bid sheet. You may choose to bid more than the incremental minimum. There is no limit.
- The last bid at closing time will constitute the winning bid. If the winning bidder is not present, we will make every effort to contact that person over the next week. If after 7 days we are not able to track down the winner, we will make the item available to the second place winner, etc.
- Payment by the winning bidder must be received at the end of the event or within 7 days of notification. The auction items will not be released until payment in full is made. Checks may be made out to **Kali McKellips Fund**.
- All sales are final, and no exchanges or refunds will be made. Do not bid on an item unless you are prepared to purchase it.
- All items are sold “as is”, and in no event shall the organizers be responsible for the correctness of the item described.
- Auction items must be used within one year, unless otherwise specified. Dates and times are arranged at the mutual convenience of the donor and the buyers unless stated otherwise.
- All auction items must be removed the evening of the event if the winner is present.
- Values are donor estimates only and do not necessarily represent certified appraisal.
- Because of the nature of the fundraising activity, the money spent to purchase any auction items is not tax deductible. It was a difficult decision to make, but one that we feel will help Kali and her family the most.
